The City of Orlando has put together a great parking program for you that includes access to the following garages and lots, which are located closest to the new Amway Center. Parking for these garages and lots will be \$10 per event unless otherwise noted below.

- 55 West
- Church St. Garage (\$20)
- Geico Garage (\$20)
- Garland Ave. Lot
- Lot 9 (under I-4) – main lot for season ticket holders with disabilities
- Lot 10 (under I-4)
- Administration Garage
- Central Blvd. Garage
- Jefferson St. Garage
- Library Garage
- Washington St. Garage
- Robinson Lot

### **Your Priority Number**

Your pre-paid, reserved parking selection opportunity will be based on your Orlando Magic priority number (the year you opened your current full season ticket account). For example, those with 1986 priority numbers will have the first opportunity to select, followed by 1987, 1988 and all the way through our newest season ticket holders in 2010.

In the near future you will be receiving additional information from us about how to select and pay for your pre-paid, reserved parking. It will be done through a convenient web-based program that will allow you to select the garage or lot of your choice (based on availability), how many games you want to reserve parking for during the 2010-2011 Orlando Magic season, purchase your parking, and print your parking permits.
